

Optional Field Trip to Aluminium of Greece 23rd September 2019



For more than half a century now, Aluminium of Greece plant – today the Metallurgy Business Unit of MYTILINEOS SA -- is one of the leading players in the Greek heavy industries sector. Aluminium of Greece was established as a company in 1960 by Pechiney, the French metallurgy giant of that time, in order to exploit the rich bauxite deposits of the Central Greece Region for producing alumina and aluminium. The value of this investment, which proved a key strategic investment that drove economic growth and the development of know-how in Greece, multiplied over the years. In 2005, Aluminium of Greece became a member of the then MYTILINEOS Group and has since evolved into Europe's only vertically integrated alumina, aluminium and bauxite production and trading plant.

Under a significant investment plan, the annual production capacity reaches 820,000 tons of alumina and 185,000 tons of aluminium.

Located in Agios Nikolaos, Viotia, on the northern coast of the Corinthian Gulf, the industrial complex of ALUMINIUM OF GREECE occupies an area of 75 hectares and employs 1,050 people directly and more than 400 indirectly, all of them residents in the wider region.

From its establishment to this day, the plant has been a catalyst for local growth and is proud to support – and be supported by – generations of employees who are the driving force of an industry that is developing pioneering knowhow at the global level.
